



The InfraGard Birmingham Members Alliance is a collaborative group that supports the InfraGard membership affiliated with the Birmingham, Alabama, field office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). **InfraGard** is an FBI-sponsored public/private information sharing partnership comprised of over 80 local chapters that are affiliated with FBI Field Offices around the country. Members are individuals from industry, academia, and law enforcement who have a strong interest in the protection of our nation's infrastructure, and they have passed a criminal history check with the FBI. Birmingham InfraGard was started on September 6, 2001, and has established itself as one of the strongest chapters nationwide by providing key advice on critical cyber-security issues. InfraGard chapters do not charge dues but do incur expenses. Monthly meetings are held at area venues where the most current topics are discussed that concern digital data and communication. Best practices are shared, and trusted relationships are built.

The Birmingham FBI provides a Special Agent Coordinator who serves as a liaison to the chapter and encourages two-way sharing of intelligence that concerns the safety of individuals, enterprises, and government entities. This type of data sharing is crucial to the defense of our assets and liberties.
